

Murder on a mountain

Assignment 3

You are now ready to help the police!

Day 1

The Inspector Blanc wishes to interview the following tourists. Using the techniques you have just learnt find the names of the following tourists. In Word under the heading *Day 1* keep a record of the First and Last names of each of the tourists to give Inspector Blanc.

- A man with **black** hair seen leaving to begin a climb at **08:10** (am).
- Four people with **black** hair seen returning from the walking area at **07:05** (pm).
- A **blonde** man named **Lime** was seen talking to the victim on **15 May 2001**.

Day 2

The witnesses yesterday gave the police some very valuable information. Can you help the police track down the murderer given the following information? **Ask to be shown how to produce an Advanced Filter!**

- The dead man was about 30 and of average height and weight. He had been pushed into a ravine. Police are reluctant to say whether the murderer was a man or a woman. Estimated time of death is between 6 and 7 in the evening on the 7 July.
- A footprint in the snow is estimated to be size 8. Since the police know the dead man had size 6 it can't be his.
- A group of climbers report two people, one fitting the description of the dead man and another with brown hair walking up the mountain on the 7th at 3.30 that afternoon.

Have you found the murderer? Who do you suspect? Remember to keep detailed notes in Word under the heading *Day 2*.

Day 3

Unfortunately Inspector Blanc does not have enough information to charge anyone.

After extensive research, a new witness comes forward. She remembers seeing two cars, one licence plate showing the town that may have begun Sea... and telephone ending in 2448, at the bottom of the mountain.

Can the police arrest a suspect now? Write down the name, address and 'phone number for the police under *Day 3* in Word document.
